## 1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The PCRA of NSW, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct Club Road Race Meeting for P4, P5, P6, Pre Modern, Motolite, Superlite, Commuterlite Solos, P4, P5; Modern Sidecars at Sydney Motorsport Park, on Saturday $23^{\text {RD }}$ September 2017 The event is open to financial members of PCRA.

## JURISDICTION:

The above-mentioned CLUB meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number TBA and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences.
2. One Meeting Licenses will be available for this meeting BUT MUST BE APPLIED FOR PRIOR TO THE MEETING. Cost of One Meeting Licence is $\$ 80.00$ and application form can be obtained from PCRA website: www.postclassicracing.com.au in addition the MA Theory Test must accompany this application.
The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.
by entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws and INSTRUCTIONS.

## 3. ENTRIES:

Entries open forthwith and Paper or Emailed entries close last mail Friday $1^{\text {st }}$ September 2017 (Reminder that mail can and does take up to 1 week). Online Entries close midnight $8^{\text {th }}$ September 2017.
In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the promoter, if such retention is approved by Motorcycling NSW.
Only entries received on the official entry form or online on the PCRA website that are accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
NOTE: LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE AUTOMATICALLY BE ACCEPTED. THEY MAY BE ACCEPTED INCURRING A LATE FEE OF $\mathbf{\$ 5 0}$, OR REJECTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE RACE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE OR CLUB EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.
Entries WILL NOT be processed until payment is received and verified.

SCRUTINEERING: All entrants are reminded to consult the manual of Motorsports on the MA website if they have any questions about any issues e.g. race numbers, belly pans, fluids or lockwiring. Machine scrutineering at this meeting will be strict regarding compliance with MoMs.
Bellypans of machines required to have them MUST be removed to allow inspection access and to check the catch tray volume. Any such machines presenting without the bellypan removed will be required to take it off and re-present. Anyone whose bellypan needs more time to reinstall, especially if they are in the first session should ask a Scrutineer if they can be checked early.
All water-cooled machines WILL be tested for glycol. This requires access to a few drops either via filler cap or a loosened hose. Any glycol found will need to be cleared out before passing scrutineering.
Lockwiring will be held to our normal standards. Any R-clips must be secured so they cannot be removed by hand or a blow.

## 4. INSURANCE:

4.1 National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
4.2 Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.

## IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

Ambulance and Paramedical services will be provided in accordance with Motorcycling NSW regulations from 9am to 5 pm on Saturday $26^{\text {TH }}$ August, 2017
6. ENTRY FEE:
6.1 Solo Entry \$ 325.00 includes the hire of one transponder \& a space in a garage.
6.2 Sidecar Entry $\$ 370.00$ - includes the hire of 1 transponder \& passenger levy \& a space in a garage.
$6.3 \quad \$ 95.00$ for each additional machine/class entered includes an extra transponder \& extra space in a garage.
6.4 A \$50 LATE ENTRY FEE WILL BE INCURRED FOR THE APPROVED ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER CLOSING DATE if accepted. 6.5 Payment by Credit Card, Cheque, Direct Deposit or Money Order only. (ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT). Payment by Credit Card on-line at https://www.pcra.com.au/events/suppregs/

## 7. ENTRY PASSES:

None required. No admission fee is required to enter the circuit for this meeting.
8. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

P4 0-250, 350, 500, 750, Unlimited. P5 0-250, 350, 500, 750, Unlimited, P6 125, 250 GP, 250 Production, 500, 750,
1300cc, Pre Modern F1, F2, F250GP, F3. P4, P5, Modern Sidecars, Motolites, Superlites and Commuterlites.
9. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

Medallions will be awarded to the first three placegetters in each race category

## 10. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

10.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be a minimum of six for solos and six for sidecars.
10.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition; the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling NSW approval.
10.3 Should a race be oversubscribed, the PCRA reserves the right to place the excess riders on a reserve list, or amend the classes within a race. The riders will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt of entry.
11. RACE FORMAT:

See 21.
Scoring will be as per GCR's. i.e. 25 points will be allocated to the overall $1^{\text {st }}$ place at the end of each race, 20 pts for $2^{\text {nd }}$ place, 18 pts for $3^{\text {rd }}$ place, 17 points for $4^{\text {th }}$ place, 16 points for $5^{\text {th }}$ place, etc., to be accumulated over the event.

## 12. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

12.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCR's for their class of competition and where applicable the PCRA Pre Modern, Motolite, Superlite and Commuterlite Rules
12.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
12.3 Change of machine or rider must be advised in writing to the Race Secretary up to 30 minutes prior to the event and verified by the Clerk of the Course.
12.4 ELIGIBILITY: All machines for Historic Racing are to be eligible in accordance with the MOMs and have an MA Historic Log Book. Any machine found ineligible will forfeit any award and may be excluded from the meeting. It is the entrants/riders responsibility to ensure their machine is eligible for Australian Historic Racing. Machines must be eligible for historic competition and endorsed by the eligibility scrutineer. Entrants should come prepared with ORIGINAL documents to prove eligibility of major components, copies of documents will not be accepted. Approval at previous events does not automatically guarantee acceptance of eligibility.
12.5 Noise \&/or Fuel Testing may be carried out at any time during this meeting.
13. RIDING NUMBERS:
13.1 Competitors will be allocated their Motorcycling NSW Registered Riding Number or their preferred riding number if available. All others shall be allocated numbers at the PCRA's discretion.
13.2 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's.
14. GRID POSITIONS:

Grid positions for race 1 will be determined by qualifying. Grids for subsequent heats will be determined by the finishing position of the previous race.
15. RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of qualifying and ALL competitors MUST attend. Riders' briefing sign-on sheets MUST be signed by the competitor as confirmation of attendance.

## 16. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

By order of Motorcycling NSW, random drug \&/or alcohol testing of participants (i.e. officials, competitors, mechanics, pit crew and any other person associated with the control, direction and operation of the competition) may take place prior to, or at any time during this meeting.

## 17. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

20. STARTS:

Starts will be by the use of lights. If lights fail, starts will be by raising the Australian Flag.

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's.
23. PAYG WITHOUT HOLDING:

## 24. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

24.1 Entries close strictly at close of entry date. Late entries will ONLY be accepted under extenuating circumstances and if accepted will incur a late entry fee of $\$ 50$.
24.2 Transponders will be used for obtaining of lap times and scoring.
24.3 The hire of transponders are incorporated in the entry fee.
24.4 Your Competition License will be required as deposit for transponder/s. Loss, damage and/or replacement cost will be the responsibility of the competitor ( $\$ 655$ )
24.5 Additional machines will require a separate transponder for each machine entered.
24.6 All competitors MUST wear leathers and boots to riders gear inspection, so that we can check your gear while in the Inspection queue. If not wearing leathers you will not have gear inspected. Rider must have helmets which comply with current MA Rules. All riders must have proof of club membership at the ready.
24.7 Final Instructions and list of riders will be posted on the PCRA website.
24.8 FUEL: Fuel used in all events at this meeting must be in accordance with MOM's.

As a reminder: Be an unleaded fuel that is no more than 100 RON, unless machines are P2, P3, P4 solo and sidecar and P5 Sidecars which may use Methanol or AV Gas and leaded fuel.
As advised in MOM's E85 or similar fuels or any other additives are totally banned.
24.9 Fuel is now available for sale at the circuit.
24.10 No BBQ's and/or naked flames permitted in the pits during racing.
24.11 BBQ will be available after the completion of racing.
24.12 Trophy presentation will be held at the conclusion of racing.

HEREBY AGREE with Motorcycling Australia Limited ("MA") that I am by this agreement entitled to participate in the motorcycle activity/meeting listed in Schedule 2 (hereinafter called "the Meeting" or the "Event") at the venue listed at Schedule 3 (hereinafter called "the Venue") on the terms and conditions set out in this document. 2. DEFINITIONS In this declaration:
a) "Claim" means and includes any action, suit, proceeding, claim, demand, damage, cost or expense however arising including but not limited to negligence but does not include a claim against a Motorcycling Organisation under any right expressly conferred by its constitution or regulation,
b) "Indemnities" means and includes the persons, organisations and bodies corporate whose names appear in Schedule 1.
"MA" means Motorcycling Australia Limited;
d) "State Controlling Body" (SCB) means a state or territory motorcycling association affiliated as a member of MA;
e) "Motorcycling Activities" means performing or participating in any capacity in any authorised or recognised Motorcycling Organisation event, meeting or activity;
f) "Motorcycling Organisation" means and includes MA, and the MA members (including the SCBs and affiliated clubs) and where the context so permits, their respective directors, officers, members, servants or agents.

## 3. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS \& OBLIGATIONS

## I ACKNOWLEDGE that:

a) Motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and dangers and am under certain obligations as follows:
i) That I may be injured, physically or mentally, and may be killed;
ii) That my machinery or equipment may be damaged, lost or destroyed;
iii) That competitors may ride dangerously or with a lack of skill;
iv) That track or event conditions may be hazardous and may vary without warning or predictability,
v) that organisers, officials, landowners/track operators and any agents or representatives of those in charge of meetings are frequently obliged to make decisions under pressure of time/or events;
vi) That any policy of insurance of or in respect of my life or physical or mental health may be voided;
vii) That there may be no or inadequate facilities for treatment or transport of me if am injured;
vii) That I have an obligation to myself and to others to act safely and within the rules and regulations of MA;
b) the Indemnities do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
c) To the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law;
d) Have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event.
4. WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and accept responsibility for the cost f ambulance transportation, ambulance cover and further agree to maintain abulance cover during the term of my license / membership.
